Support Services

- Training, workshops and resource materials on a variety of subjects

Will my supervisor be notified?

All counseling services are confidential unless divulgence is required by law. Your supervisor will not be notified unless authorized by you.



Supervisor Referrals

Early assistance is critical to prevent problems from developing into major issues. TCTI can provide a supervisor consultation for concerns about an employee. A supervisor may suggest an initial counseling session if they believe there are work performance problems. The decision to continue counseling is the personal responsibility of the employee. An employee's job security and opportunities for promotion will not be impacted by a supervisor referral.

NOTE: Since your agency has contracted with us, there are no fees for our counseling services. There are times, however, when individuals may be referred to resources outside the program. Should an employee or eligible family member decide to utilize these outside resources, they will be responsible for any fees associated for those services.
